Exploring Asian Traditional and Contemporary Food Cultures in Asian Cities through *Reflections on Food and Culture in Asia*

One week in Fukuoka, Japan (Aug. 5-13, 2023)

Overview: A specialized summer study program that explores traditional and modern Asian cuisine and culture through field trips and special lectures—all taught in English—in Fukuoka, Japan, home to both centuries-old and modern avant-garde culinary styles. Over the course, participants will immerse themselves in history and contemporary culture to learn and reflect on the complexities of modern Asia. The participants will gain a clear understanding of the role of culture and history in shaping Asian societies and what is currently driving them forward.

The program offers the opportunity to:

- **Gain** comprehensive and in-depth knowledge about Asian countries through short-term study abroad in Asian cities (Fukuoka, Japan).
- **Engage** with local faculty members and fellow students from Mahidol University (Thailand), Ewha Womans University (Korea) and Fukuoka Women's University (Japan) through special lectures and hands-on experiences.
- **Explore** food culture in Asia, gaining insight into how it is manifest in Asian society and tradition and comparing it to the Western context.
- **Experience** local corporate culture through seminars and field visits to the offices of experts and professionals.
- **Equip yourself** for international work by acquiring an in-depth understanding of Asian cultures, geography, history, and languages.

Duration: August 5 - August 13, 2023

※Our planned pickup times are 10am and 3pm on Aug 5 at International Terminal of Fukuoka Airport. Please arrange air flight to arrive before this time. EAT participants must leave the dormitory by noon of August 13 after the program ends on August 12.

Eligibility: Undergraduate/graduate FEMALE students are eligible to apply. No Thai, Korean or Japanese language skills are required.

Credits: Participants may earn credits by home university.

Tuition Fee: 42,000 JPY

Tuition fee includes field trips, accommodation. Airfare is NOT included.

Scholarships: A scholarship of 80,000 JPY will be given up to 10 students each from Ewha and Mahidol. (GPA 2.30/3.0 or above is requested to be eligible for scholarship)

Application: Application deadline is **June 9(Fri), 2023.**
